| Theme | Civil Rights Movement (U.S.) | Holocaust (Europe) |

| Historical Context | Segregation and racial discrimination under Jim Crow laws in the United States | Antisemitism and totalitarian control under Nazi Germany |
| Targeted Group | African Americans | Jewish people and other persecuted groups |
| Youth at the Center | Emmett Till , a 14-year-old boy whose murder exposed racial terror | Anne Frank , a teenage girl whose diary revealed life under persecution |
| Systemic Injustice | Biased legal systems, all-white juries, lack of accountability | Laws stripping rights, ghettos, deportations, and state-organized murder |
| Role of Families | Mamie Till-Mobley demanded the world witness the truth | Otto Frank preserved Anne's words to educate future generations |
| Public Awareness | Photographs and media coverage sparked national outrage | Survivor testimony and documentation revealed genocide |
| Response to Injustice | Nonviolent protest, boycotts, and organized resistance | Underground resistance, documentation, survival, and testimony |
| Global Impact | Fueled the Civil Rights Movement and future equality laws | Led to international human rights awareness and “Never Again” |
| Core Lesson | Silence allows injustice to continue | Indifference enables atrocity |
| Message for Today | Speak up against racism and inequality | Confront hatred and defend human dignity |



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
